

them have been tested—and proven—where it counts. In fact, when the chips are down, some may cost you your life—a high price to pay for having the wrong knife. That's why professional military men—whose very lives can depend on their knives—seek out battle-proven knives.

Any knifemaker can make idle claims. And most do. But look for a knife with proven ability. Preferably one that is <u>battle</u> proven.



mando Knives have arrived at a level of technology beyond that of other production knives. State-of-the-art materials such as the specially-developed HCS1718 highcarbon stainless steel and the finest hilt components complement the basic, timetested design.

Be it a military maneuver in distant lands, a SWAT operation in the streets or a hunting trip in the wilderness, if your knife doesn't survive, you might not either. Other knives may be satisfactory under normal circumstances—Ek Knives are designed for when your life depends on it.

More Steel Than Any Other Knife of Their Size and Type

When you acquire an Ek Commando Knife, you're not throwing your money

away on gimmicks. You're investing in steel and skilled American hand-craftsmanship. We make our knives with more steel than any other knife of their size and type. They feature a full-length, full-width tang. That's a solid bar of steel running through the grips, which is unmatched for strength. Most other knives have a short "stub" tang or a narrow "rat-tail" tang that can break. Worse yet, knives that have no

tang at all—the blade is simply pinned or welded to the grip in a joint which can fail when you least expect it, and when you need your knife the most.

With the Ek full-length, full-width tang, you can take off one or both of the grips and still have a one-inch by five and one-half inch solid bar of steel—still a handful of handle.

"On October, 1967, at Bien Hoa in III Corps, I was in a gunship flying an insert mission . . . we took beaucoup hits from a .51-caliber and the ship went down . . . I took my Ek Commando Knife (issued to me by MACV-SOG) and pounded on the door. No good. So, I jammed the knife through the metal skin and cut my way out. The knife cut it like butter. The hole was big enough to get out—over two feet across. The Charlies didn't see us—the only weapon we had was the Ek Knife.

"We both made it through 23 klicks of jungle with a knife as protection. We had to dispose of two VC with it. Again, it did the job, never losing its edge. Without that knife, we both would be dead.

"I have opened C-rat cans with it, cut ammo cans open, cut parachute webbing with it, pounded nails and chopped tree limbs with it. I have busted Ka-bars doing the same jobs.

"In July, 1970, I dropped HALO into a bad LZ, lost our equipment, and I busted my stock on my Matty Matel M-16. Again, the knife and a 9mm is all I had.

"I had only two clips of 13 each ammo. Some VC regulars rushed us and I went low on ammo. That damn, beautiful knife took three of them out, one stroke each. We got back to base camp and we made it because of the knife.

I am a very firm believer that you have the finest knife in the world to-day...the U.S. Army (should) get one for every soldier to use."

Customize Your Own Full-Tang Ek Grip System

Ek Commando Knives use two sophisticated grip systems. With the first, you get three solid brass, custom machine-turned fittings which are removable for cleaning or replacement. At a time when other knives typically use just two fasteners, Ek uses three. It's a little more expensive, but if one should ever become loose (unlikely), you've got two others to keep it from wobbling. When you start out with only two fasteners, and one becomes loose, you get a

loose grip right away. Just look in your kitchen knife drawer.

Another grip option is the unique Ek Paragrip™ which is 18 feet of military-specification, 550-pound tensile strength parachute cord. The Ek Paragrip™ provides a tough, non-slip grip which can be easily unwrapped and rewrapped. Originated and developed by Ek years ago, these days this grip system is often copied by other knifemakers.

Ek also provides a variety of sheath options. The high-quality olive drab nylon

web sheath, automatically included with virtually every Ek Knife, is nylon lock stitched, fitted with rivets for extra strength and wrapped with six additional feet of pcord for utility or emergency tie down. If you prefer another sheath combination, you may substitute either the black web sheath, or the black or brown deluxe leather sheath which features dual leather, velcro-backed retaining straps and 20 additional feet of specially-wrapped p-cord. All Ek sheaths will fit wide military belts, and all are handmade in America.

Proven in World War II, Korea and Vietnam


